
Framework Agreement

Regarding participation in the RightMesh AG (RightMesh) Crowd Contribution in exchange for R M E S H - tokens, through Bitcoin Suisse AG (BTCSAG)

This agreement covers the participation in the RightMesh Crowd Contribution, through Bitcoin Suisse AG.

From Tuesday, 17th of April 2018, 1 p.m. (CEST), the public gets an opportunity to register to participate in the RightMesh Crowd Contribution, through BTCSAG. Once registered and approved, their wallet address will be whitelisted to participate where their contributions are rewarded with RMESH tokens.

Registrations for participating in the crowd contribution received before Thursday, 17th of May 2018, 1 p.m. (CEST), and approved by BTCSAG, will be whitelisted by the start of the respective contribution period. Registrations received after the deadline on the 17th of May 2018 at 1 p.m. (CEST) will be processed on a best-effort basis and whitelisted, if approved by BTCSAG, into the RightMesh contribution smart contract twice per day.

The RMESH/USD rate for the public crowd contribution is 1 RMESH/USD. The final USD/ETH rate will be locked 3 hours (three hours) before the opening of the contribution period. The rate is locked from Bitstamp USD/ETH market.

The contribution period is planned to start on Wednesday, May 30th at 1 p.m. (CEST). The period will run for a maximum of 2 weeks, or until the total hard cap for the public contribution for the project is hit.

The crowd contribution period will consist of two contribution tracks:

- **Small Cap track**, for the first 24 hours, for contributions from 1'000 (USD) up to a limit that will be communicated prior to the start of the crowd contribution.

- **Large Cap** track, for the remaining contribution period, there shall be no maximum enforced other than the individual contributors contribution limit as fully determined by BTCSAG. The minimum contribution of 1'000 (USD) equivalent shall remain in place

Every contributor approved and whitelisted for the crowd contribution will be approved for a contribution up to a limit, which is fully determined by BTCSAG. Each Contributor's individual limit is determined and required according to the KYC and AML compliance.

In the first 24-hour period, after the opening of the crowd contribution period, every approved and whitelisted contributor will be able to contribute up to a limit that will be communicated prior to the start of the crowd contribution.

After the first 24-hour period, every approved and whitelisted contributor can contribute up to the individual contribution limit, determined and communicated by BTCSAG.

Participating through Bitcoin Suisse AG

Bitcoin Suisse AG acts as a disclosed agent of the user and performs KYC/AML procedure for whitelisting contribution addresses to the RightMesh Smart Contract System and/or RightMesh, allowing the address to contribute to the Smart Contract System, under the respective contribution caps. Please note that BTCSAG is thereby not in control of the RightMesh Smart Contract System and/or RightMesh.

The contribution offering will operate in a first-come-first-serve manner

Terms

Contributors will be charged a handling fee, for the KYC/AML onboarding and regulatory responsibility at BTCSAG, of 1.25% when sending ETH in to the Smart Contract Solution, which is then transferred to BTCSAG.

Onboarding

The BTCSAG Compliance department may ask the contributor to provide various documents for the purpose of KYC and AML procedures. The Client grants BTCSAG permission to use and share the collected information, by BTCSAG, for regulatory and compliance purposes (e.g. for the involved bank or financial intermediaries) and with RightMesh.

BTCSAG reserves the right to unilaterally turn down any request for a business relationship, if BTCSAG so wishes.

Token Receiving Address / Contribution Address

The Contributor is responsible for providing BTCSAG with a valid and compatible Token Receiving Address / Contribution Address when registering for the RightMesh Crowd Contribution on the BTCSAG platform.

The Contributor confirms that he is in full control of the private key to the provided Token Receiving Address / Contribution Address.

The Contributor understands and acknowledge that a Token Receiving Address / Contribution Address, to which the Contributor does not hold the private key (e.g. Exchange wallet address) can result in loss of tokens.

Further, the Contributor guarantees the he/she is the only beneficial owner of the address. If there are more beneficial owners to the address, this must be disclosed and approved by BTCSAG.

The Contributor accepts and acknowledges that BTCSAG under no circumstances can be held liable for any losses or damages caused by sending Tokens to an invalid, non-compatible, or in any other way not-

functioning Token Receiving Address / Contribution Address provided by said Contributor.

Further, the Contributor accepts and acknowledges that BTCSAG's exemption of liability as described above also extends to token distributions facilitated by others where BTCSAG is not involved in any way.

It is the responsibility of the contributor that the requirements are met. If they are not met, BTCSAG has no liability towards any losses sustained by the Contributor hereof.

If BTCSAG is **NOT** in control of the tokens and is **NOT** responsible for the distribution of the Tokens, BTCSAG has **no responsibility** towards the Contributor in regards to token Distribution.

Liabilities

BTCSAG is responsible for the proper accounting of — and regulatory compliance/AML, in regards to Swiss rules and regulations of all contributions and associated transactions.

BTCSAG holds no other liabilities towards contributors than the above mentioned. BTCSAG is acting merely as a financial intermediary and KYC/AML provider, between contributors and the RightMesh project and its founders.

BTCSAG does in no way hold any liabilities in regard to promises made by RightMesh, nor do it endorse the project or have any opinion in regard to its merits.

BTCSAG asks all contributors to remember that crypto-projects are always risky endeavors, which are usually characterized by high probability of failure and equally high potential returns. We ask any contributor to do his own due/diligence on the projects & assets in question, as well as the organizations and people behind them.

Established crypto-currencies themselves are already highly volatile and risky assets, ICO-offerings of crypto-tokens yet unproven must always be classified **as extremely risky assets!**

This Agreement shall be governed, construed and interpreted pursuant to and in accordance with the laws of Switzerland. The Courts of the Canton of Zug shall have exclusive Jurisdiction for all matters related to this Agreement.
